Enjoy the sights and sounds of Chicago aboard the Red Witch, a 77 foot gaff rig topsail schooner designed by John G. Alden, long considered one of the world's greatest naval architects and classic yacht designers. Schooners were the most important sailing ships in American history and very important to the development of the Great lakes region in the 19th century. In the 1860's peak period, there were 1800 working schooners in the Great Lakes linking the growing towns of the Midwest shores with the East Coast, bringing lumber, corn, produce, livestock, and people, between these destinations.
