Paddle along the coastal waters and discover the beauty as we uncover the historic significance of the La Jolla Sea Caves during Prohibition, and their role in San Diego's history. Paddle to the Arch Cave and Sunny Jim's Cave to witness amazing sandstone formations and, weather permitting, head into the Clam's Cave – the largest of the 7 Sea Caves. Watch sea lions bask in the sun, pelicans fly over head, and a wide variety of marine mammals, sea birds, fishes, and plant life that call this area home. With so much wildlife in the area, there's plenty to explore and discover.

- Begin by checking in, gearing up and a brief kayak lesson with paddling instruction at the meeting point
- Spend the day with an experienced guide paddling the clear waters of the Caves of La Jolla and Ecological Reserve
- Enjoy one-of-a-kind views of caves, the coastline, and wildlife
- Finish off your kayak tour by riding a wave back to shore
